Strategic Planning Activities

Each committee chair reviewed their current working document and provided an evaluation focused on a series of questions designed to look both retrospectively and prospectively: Is the charge, mission and vision of each committee accurate? Is the committee achieving its goals and objectives? What are ongoing objectives? And, what new goals and objectives are being considered for the future? These reports provide valuable insight, recommendations and direction for the

Academy of Laser Dentistry. The strategic planning committee then worked with the board of directors, in groups, to critically evaluate and answer additional questions: Is the strategic plan consistent with the Mission of the Academy? Is the committee and administrative structure meeting the needs of the Academy? What is the process for the development of leadership? Does the strategic plan meet the needs of our members? What are areas of strength and areas of weakness? In the next 5 years, what are the issues that the Academy should address? The results of this review of our strategic plan will provide the foundation for the strategic planning committee's annual review and report to the board at the board meeting in March 2004.
