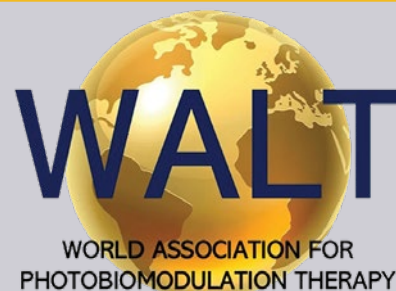

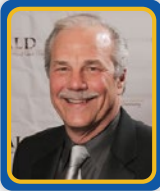

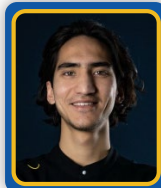

The choice of which laser best suits your practice, your patients and how you want to differentiate and market yourself is not an easy one. Because no one wavelength can do everything, it is important to understand limitations of each and how combining lasers and create confidence in the best possible outcome for the clinician and minimal complications and fastest recovery for the patient. Erbium lasers are known for fast cutting of both soft and hard tissues including bone, dentin and enamel with minimal thermal effects but often lack in deep and predictable coagulation and disinfection. Diode lasers are not indicated for contact with hard tissues due to deep thermal side-effects, but that is what makes them superior in coagulation and disinfection. By knowing the strength and weaknesses of all laser wavelengths and how lasers are different from conventional instruments like scalpels, electro-surgery and drills, we can develop multi-wavelength treatment protocols easy to implement into everyday practice. So bring your typical daily schedule and we will help you to turn your conventional day into a laser-assisted next level of patient care day using Er,Cr:YSGG 2780nm erbium family laser and Epic 940nm diode family laser.

As demand for minimally invasive, efficient soft-tissue procedures continues to grow, diode lasers have become an essential tool in modern dentistry. However, many clinicians remain uncertain about proper technique, settings, and clinical application. This program is specifically structured to bridge that gap. The workshop begins with a focused one-hour lecture reviewing the foundational principles of diode laser dentistry, including laser physics, tissue interaction, and safety protocols. Emphasis will be placed on practical understanding rather than theory alone, enabling participants to make predictable and biologically sound clinical decisions. The lecture will also introduce multiple diode laser wavelengths and highlight their clinical versatility, preparing participants to work with different systems and technologies. Following the didactic portion, participants will engage in an intensive 2 to 2.5-hour hands-on session featuring live demonstrations and guided mentorship. Attendees will practice on animal tissue models, simulating real clinical scenarios to develop tactile familiarity and procedural confidence. CO₂ Laser Workshop

Soft tissue surgery is common in clinical dentistry and can be performed by different types of lasers. General practitioners prefer to feel contact with the soft tissue during incision, excision or coagulation of blood vessels. This course will present and train clinicians to understand the difference between contact and non-contact laser surgery. The CO₂ laser as the most common laser wavelength for oral surgical procedures allows an excellent cutting efficiency and provides opportunities in the treatment of periodontal and peri-implant diseases with significant benefits for patients and clinicians. Pre-prosthetic surgery, removal of benign soft-tissue tumors, coagulation of hemangiomas, excision of precancerous lesions such as leucoplakias, management of drug-induced gingival overgrowths, and the treatment of peri-implantitis. These examples will outline the relevant clinical protocols and highlight the importance of choosing the correct laser wavelength for clinical daily practice.

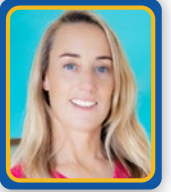

AI-Guided Personalized Brain Intervention (PBI): A Live Demonstration of Real-Time Adaptive Photobiomodulation

Until now, brain photobiomodulation (PBM) has generally relied on parameters selected manually before stimulation and then kept fixed during a session. However, biological responses can differ between individuals and may change over time. In medicine, treatment is often adjusted according to measured physiological responses. Personalized Brain Intervention (PBI) brings this feedback principle to brain PBM by measuring how an individual brain responds, selecting the next permitted PBM input based on that response, delivering it, and measuring again. EEG provides a non-invasive window into the brain's electrical activity, while AI assists in selecting among human-approved PBM settings.

This 3.5-hour, two-part workshop combines practical explanation, case discussion, and a live end-to-end demonstration with a consenting adult volunteer. Using Vielight AI and the programmable Neuro Pro platform, participants will observe the cycle repeat approximately every five seconds: recording EEG, assessing the current response, selecting from predefined PBM settings within human-set safety limits, delivering PBM, and remeasuring and adapting. The projected interface will display signal quality, the selected setting, loop count, and time-stamped responses. Presenters will explain, in clinically relevant terms, what EEG can and cannot show, how movement and other artifacts are managed, why human oversight remains essential, and how adaptive PBI should be compared with the best fixed protocol. No prior EEG or computational background is required.

By the end of the workshop, participants will understand how PBI differs from conventional fixed PBM, recognize the respective roles of EEG, AI, PBM, and human oversight, observe a complete adaptive loop in real time, and identify the scientific evidence required before clinical conclusions can be drawn.

PBI points to a potential next evolution of precision PBM: not simply delivering a preset dose of light, but creating a continuing, measurable dialogue between the intervention and the brain. Future systems may learn which wavelength, pulse frequency, intensity, timing, and delivery sites produce a desired measurable response in a particular brain, then refine that response profile across sessions. This approach could help the PBM field investigate individual variability, distinguish responders from non-responders, improve reproducibility, and design more informative clinical studies. The live demonstration is intended to show technical operation and the ability to measure and respond to selected EEG features; it does not establish clinical benefit, diagnosis, or superiority.

Participants will learn to explain PBI and distinguish it from manually selected, fixed PBM protocols; describe the live PBI cycle and the roles of EEG, AI, PBM, and human oversight; relate PBI to individual biological variability and the future of precision PBM; and identify the evidence needed to determine whether adaptive PBI is reproducible and clinically meaningful.

Preventing Neurodegeneration Through Whole-Body PBM: A Network Solution to the Gut-Brain-Sleep Axis

Neurodegenerative diseases are increasingly recognized as systemic network disorders involving the gut-brain axis, glymphatic clearance system, and chronic neuroinflammation rather than isolated brain failures. Current photobiomodulation (PBM) approaches predominantly use transcranial or site-specific irradiation, which cannot directly address the gut-brain axis, activate glymphatic drainage, or target systemic inflammation. This workshop presents a paradigm shift: whole-body PBM (WB-PBM) as a simultaneous, multi-axis preventive strategy targeting the gut, brain, and sleep-glymphatic system within a single session.

This 3-hour interactive workshop combines didactic presentation with a live physiological demonstration. The presentation will cover the mechanistic rationale for WB-PBM across three primary axes: gut-brain axis pathology, including Braak's hypothesis, mapranosis, and LPS-driven neuroinflammation; glymphatic system dysfunction, including AQP4-mediated clearance and sleep architecture; and the potential triple synergy of WB-PBM through a 20-minute physiological cascade. A live demonstration will feature pre- and post-session physiological assessment of a volunteer using PPG Stress Flow (BioTekna) to evaluate HRV and vascular health parameters, including RMSSD, SDNN, DFA α_1 , and stress index, as well as hemoencephalography (HEG) to assess prefrontal cortex blood flow and oxygenation. The volunteer will undergo a 20-minute WB-PBM session using the Hue Light USA Whole-Body PBM Chamber, Model 03, which utilizes 38,880 medical-grade LEDs delivering 530 nm green, 660 nm red, 850 nm near-infrared, and 940 nm infrared wavelengths. Manufacturer-provided parameters include an irradiance of 17–25 mW/cm², continuous-wave and pulsed modes using Nogier frequencies from 1–5000 Hz, full-body exposure including the abdominal region, and a 20-minute treatment time. The manufacturer reports a total dose of 50 J/cm² in 10 minutes. The device is FDA registered.

Supporting clinical evidence will be discussed from a pilot randomized controlled trial (NCT07271927) conducted at Pusan National University Yangsan Hospital in Korea, which received Korean MFDS approval (No. 1730, May 2024) and IRB approval (No. 23-2024-005). The study included 14 patients with Parkinson's disease who received three sessions per week for 10 weeks, for a total of 30 sessions at 20 minutes per session. Reported results demonstrated statistically significant improvements in UPDRS Part I, addressing mentation, behavior, and mood ($p = 0.008$, $r = -0.71$), as well as Seoul Verbal Learning Test immediate recall ($p = 0.009$) and Rey Complex Figure Test immediate ($p = 0.035$) and delayed recall ($p = 0.039$). Motor scores were maintained, with no serious adverse events reported. Natural deep sleep onset was observed at 7–10 minutes. During the live demonstration, acute physiological changes will be assessed, including HRV, stress index, vascular compliance, and prefrontal oxygenation. These measurements are intended to illustrate physiological responses to WB-PBM rather than establish clinical efficacy.

WB-PBM represents a potential approach to simultaneously engaging multiple physiological systems involved in neurodegeneration, including the gut-brain axis, glymphatic clearance, and systemic inflammation. Clinical evidence from Parkinson's disease provides preliminary proof-of-mechanism, while the broader potential application is as a prevention-oriented intervention before established pathology develops. Participants will gain an understanding of the mechanistic rationale for whole-body PBM and its potential role across these interconnected systems, learn to interpret real-time PPG-based HRV and HEG-based prefrontal cortex assessment data, and critically appraise the clinical evidence from the pilot RCT and its implications for prevention-oriented practice.

The pilot RCT received IRB approval (No. 23-2024-005) and Korean MFDS regulatory approval (No. 1730), and informed patient consent was obtained. The presenter discloses a consulting relationship with BrainTap and commercial involvement with BioTekna assessment devices. Assessment equipment (PPG Stress Flow) was provided by BioTekna, and the WB-PBM device was provided by Hue Light USA. No external funding was received for this workshop.

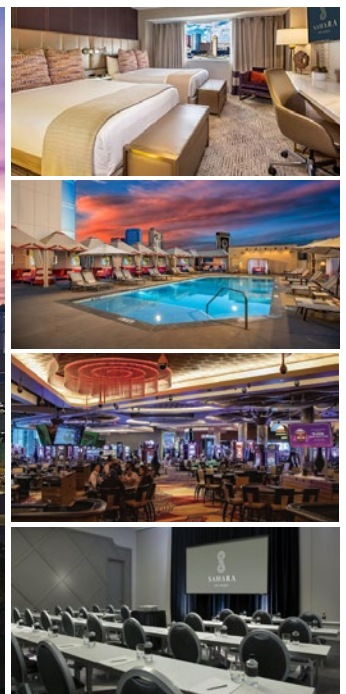
